PNEUMABORT K+1B

(Ft. Dodge)



For the vaccination of healthy horses against respiratory disease caused by EHV-1 (KV)m as well as for pregnant mares as an aid in the prevention of abortion due to EHV-1 infection. Give doses at 5th, 7th and 9th months and all non-breeding mares in contact with pregnant mares. Three doses are essential for primary immunization.

RHINOMUNE (Pfizer)

An immunization for pregnant mares, foals and horses over 3 months of age against rhinopneumonitis caused by equine herpes virus Type 1. Give 1 ml, with a booster in 4-8 weeks, and every 3 months. Note: All 5 doses must be used when rehydrated. Modified Live Vaccine

PRODIGY W/ HAVLOGEN
(Intervet)

For vaccination of healthy horses 6 months and older as an aid in the prevention of abortion and respiratory disease associated with EHV-1. For pregnant mares, give dose IM during the 5th, 7th and 9th months of pregnancy. Also vaccinate all nonpregnant mares in contact with pregnant mares.

Three doses essential for primary immunization.

Revaccination every 3 month is recommended. For horses over 9 months.

STRANGLES

Strepvax II (Boehringer Ingelheim)

Protects against strangles caused by Strep equi. Made with concentrated M-protein extract to provide good protection with a minimum amount of side effects. **Dosage:** is three 1 ml doses given at 3 week intervals initially, with an annual booster thereafter. Foals less than 3 months should receive an additional dose at 6 months or at time of weaning. Consult with your veterinarian about the advisability of vaccinating for strangles.

A 2 mL dose is placed in one nostril, followed by a second dose two to three weeks later. Pinnacle I.N. stimulates mucosal immunity at the site of natural infection for a fast, effective response.

SHIPMENT OF YOUR VACCINES

All vaccines have to be shipped at same time. When shipped properly, with ice, they can be safely shipped to you. Vaccines are shipped at the first of the week to prevent them from being in transit over the weekend. When you receive your package, the gel pac will have melted, but will have kept the vaccines safe against the heat. If you wish to have your vaccines shipped Next Day, please call for charges. Vaccines can be shipped **Second Day** for \$13.50. If you wish to use this option, please specify when ordering. You should refrigerate your vaccines.

Vaccines can not be returned nor are they refundable.

Tetanus Antitoxin	7-14 day protection for horse with deep penetrating cuts.		

*Rhinopneumonitis (viral abortion) should be given to pregnant mares in 5th, 7th and 9th months of pregnancy.

For the vaccination of healthy horses as an aid in the prevention of viremia caused by West Nile Virus. **DOSE:** Inject one 1 mL dose intramuscularly using aseptic technique. Administer a second 1 mL dose 3 to 6 weeks after the first dose. Revaccinate annually with one 1 mL dose.
